RESOLUTION NO. 8THCC-010

**DECLARING SANTIAGO CITY UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY
DUE TO TYPHOON LABUYO**

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (1) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that *“the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihoods following said events.”*;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vii) of the same code states that *“the City Mayor, as the Local Chief Executive of the City Government, shall carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities”*;

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2013, typhoon Labuyo devastated the northern part of Luzon including Santiago City that destroyed agricultural crops, infrastructure and properties;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Santiago is mandated to respond to the damages caused by the said natural calamities and to make local funds available for the purpose, hence, there is a need to declare the city under a state of calamity.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Coun. Arlene Jane Alvarez-Reyes, duly seconded, be it -


RESOLVED, as it hereby resolved, to declare Santiago City under a state of calamity due to typhoon Labuyo for all legal intents and purposes.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to allow the City Government of Santiago to utilize Eight Million Pesos (P8,000,000.00) of the Calamity Fund to fast track the rehabilitation of damages to properties and to provide social services to the affected constituents within the territorial jurisdiction of Santiago City.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Office of the President, Malacañang, Manila, the Bureau of Local Government Supervision (BLGS)-DILG, and to all persons, offices and government agencies concerned for their information and appropriate action.
