RESOLUTION NO. 8THCC-020

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. JOSEPH S. TAN, REPRESENTING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SANTIAGO, TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH SOUTHERN ISABELA COLLEGE OF ARTS AND TRADES (SICAT) RELATING TO SKILLS TRAINING IN HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATION AND OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES

 **WHEREAS**, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 7796, otherwise known as the Technical and Educational Skills Development Act (TESDA) of 1994 provides that it is “declared the policy of the State to provide relevant, accessible, high quality and efficient technical education and skills development in support of the development of high quality Filipino middle-level manpower responsive to and in accordance with Philippine development goals and priorities;”

WHEREAS, Southern Isabela College of Arts and Trades (SICAT, for brevity) located at Barangay Calaoacan, City of Santiago is a TESDA-accredited training provider whose mission is to develop competitive workforce imbued with relevant knowledge, skills, proper work values and attitudes to meet local and global manpower requirements for customers’ optimum satisfaction;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Santiago aims to develop skilled workforce among its constituents to address the issue of unemployment and underemployment;

WHEREAS, among the skills training which the City Government perceives as needed in the growing demand for horizontal and vertical development, particularly in the construction industry, are those involving heavy equipment operation, welding and other related activities;

WHEREAS, SICAT is ready, able and willing to provide the needed training programs and skills to develop highly-competent workers in such fields;


WHEREAS, Section 8(b)(1)(f) of Republic Act No. 7720, otherwise known as the Charter of the City of Santiago, empowers the City Mayor, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to existing laws or ordinances, to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents;

NOW THEREFORE, this Sanggunian **RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES**, to authorize the City Mayor, HON. JOSEPH S. TAN, representing the City Government of Santiago, to enter into and execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Southern Isabela College of Arts and Trades (SICAT) relating to skills training in heavy equipment operation and other related activities, upon such terms and conditions which the City Mayor may deem necessary, proper, legal and beneficial to the City Government of Santiago.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to all persons, offices and government agencies concerned for their information and guidance.
