**RESOLUTION NO. 8THCC-031**

**AUTHORIZING THE HON. JOSEPH SALVADOR TAN, CITY MAYOR OF  
SANTIAGO CITY, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF  
AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR  
AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE)**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) implements the DOLE Integrated Livelihood Program (DILP) pursuant to Department Order No. 36-02 in line with its effort to help the workers and private enterprises adjust to the growing competitive environment and in accordance with the accounting and auditing guidelines on the release of fund assistance to Non-Governmental Organization/People's Organization prescribed in COA Circular 2007-001;

**WHEREAS**, DOLE, through the DILP Program, promotes self-employment among rural workers and their families who have entrepreneurial potential by providing them access to the entrepreneurship training, credit and technical assistance aimed to deliver a package of interlinked services for enterprise development and provide needed employment;

**WHEREAS**, specifically, the program is addressed to the asset less and landless rural workers and who are capable of absorbing new entrepreneurial activities by helping rural workers start their livelihood projects involving production or processing and providing financial support to various proposed agricultural projects of organizations in the rural areas;

**WHEREAS**, the Bagong Buhay Farmers Association and Dubinan East RIC of Santiago City have come up with a Project Proposal, the Butchering & Meat Processing and Production of Home Care Products (Laundry Detergent & Dishwashing Liquid) and wants to be beneficiaries of the DILP Program of DOLE;

**WHEREAS**, the said project proposals call for capital counterparts from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), the Local Government Unit (LGU) for the training and other capability programs of the beneficiaries and Association's Equity, to wit:

For Bagong Buhay Farmers Association:

DOLE .....	P314,600.00
LGU .....	78,650.00
Association's Equity .....	35,000.00

For Dubinan East RIC:

DOLE .....	P204,000.00
LGU .....	37,000.00
Association's Equity .....	28,000.00

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Santiago is favorably endorsing the project proposal of Bagong Buhay Farmers Association on Butchering & Meat Processing, and the project proposal of Dubinan East RIC on Soap Production.

**WHEREFORE**, on motion of Coun. Arlene Jane Alvarez-Reyes, duly seconded, be it –


**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the Hon. Joseph Salvador Tan, City Mayor of Santiago City, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE).
