RESOLUTION NO. 8THCC-036

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. JOSEPH SALVADOR TAN, TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SANTIAGO, A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACADEMY (LGA) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) - REGION 02, IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF REGULATORY SIMPLIFICATION FOR LGU'S (RS4LGUS): ENHANCED BPLS (BUSINESS PERMIT AND LICENSING SYSTEM) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) is responsible in strengthening the capability of Local Government Units to become business-friendly and economically competitive by promoting and implementing programs and projects that will boost their economic and business potentials which includes introducing and implementing reforms to their current systems for processing business licenses and permits or adopting practices that would enable them to attract more business and investments in their communities;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Academy (LGA), as the training arm of DILG, is mandated to pursue this thrust of creating business-friendly and economically competitive LGUs in furtherance of the national government's intense efforts of further improving the country's ranking and performance in terms of global competitiveness;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Academy (LGA) implemented the Regulatory Simplification for LGU's (RS4LGUs): Enhanced BPLS (Business Permit and Licensing System) Program to support the LGUs in improving their regulatory systems and processes relating to starting a business and complements the BPLS Program by providing an in-depth analysis of the LGUs regulatory framework, hereinafter referred to as the "Project";

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Santiago City has signified its intention to avail in the implementation of this program;

WHEREAS, in order to carry out the above program, there is a need for the City Government of Santiago, the Local Government Academy (LGA), and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) - Region 02, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement for the purpose;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Coun. Aisen Faith S. Marrero, duly seconded, be it -

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Joseph Salvador Tan, to enter into and execute, for and in behalf of the City Government of Santiago, a Memorandum of Agreement with the Local Government Academy (LGA) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) - Region 02, in the implementation of Regulatory


Simplification for LGUs (RS4LGUS): Enhanced BPLS (Business Permit and Licensing System) Program.
