**FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL TRIAL COURT BRANCH 36 THE
APPLICATION FOR RELEASE ON RECOGNIZANCE OF JAY-AR DORADO Y
SOLOMON AS PROVIDED FOR BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10389**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10389 of the Recognizance Act of 2012 seeks to promote restorative justice amid problems confronting the criminal justice system such as protracted trials, inability to post bail, and congestion in jails by granting the release of an indigent detainee to the custody of a qualified member of the Barangay, City or Municipality where the person resides;

WHEREAS, Jay-Ar Dorado y Solomon of Barangay Mabini, Santiago City, accused in Criminal Case No. 36-7744 has applied before Regional Trial Court Branch 36 for release on recognizance invoking the provisions of R.A. 10389;

WHEREAS, the Trial Court duly notified the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Santiago City regarding the application of Jay-Ar Dorado y Solomon and evaluated the same that the application meets all the requirements and none of the disqualifications as provided by law;

WHEREAS, the same law mandates the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Santiago City to act on the request, in a form of resolution, for comments or opposition to the application within ten (10) days from a receipt of the notice;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Rules conducted a public hearing last December 09, 2013 and recommends the following actions:

1. To endorse the application for release on recognizance of Mr. Jay-Ar Dorado y Solomon; and
2. To suggest the following as potential custodian for the accused:
 - a. Ms. Julie G. Florentin
 - b. Barangay Council of Mabini

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Santiago City deemed it wise to act favorably on the application as it will give opportunity for offenders who meet a certain qualification to be reintegrated back into society without the agony of prolonged incarceration.


WHEREFORE, on motion of Coun. Arlene Jane Alvarez-Reyes, duly seconded, be it -

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to endorse to the Regional Trial Court Branch 36 the application for release on recognizance of Jay-Ar Dorado Y Solomon as provided for by Republic Act No. 10389.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all persons and offices concerned for their information and appropriate action.
