RESOLUTION NO. 8THCC-087

ACCREDITING VARIOUS CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) AS STRONG PARTNERS IN THE REALIZATION OF THE DEVELOPMENT GOALS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SANTIAGO

WHEREAS, Section 34, 35 and 36 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates every Local Government Unit to promote the establishment and operation of the People's and Non-Government Organizations in its jurisdiction for their remarkable contributions in the effective delivery of basis services to the people;

WHEREAS, Section 108 of the same code mandates the Local Sanggunian concerned to accredit Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and People's Organization (POs) subject to such criteria as may be provided by law;

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2013, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2013-70, with subject: "*Accreditation of Civil Society Organizations, and Selection of the Representatives to the Local Special Bodies*" setting therein the submission of documentary requirements for accreditation, to wit:

- a. Letter of application;
- b. Duly accomplished application form for accreditation;
- c. Board Resolution signifying intention for accreditation for the purpose of representation in the local special bodies;
- d. Certificate of registration or accreditation with the proper government agency;
- e. List of current officers and members;
- f. Annual Accomplishment Report for the immediate preceding year; and
- g. Financial Statement, at the minimum, signed by the Executive Officers of the organization and indicating therein other information such as the sources of funds

WHEREAS, in addition to the said requirements, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Santiago City passed Ordinance No. 6thCC-62, providing therein, as supplementary requirements, the Vicinity Map showing actual office address, and picture of existing office of all local organizations seeking for accreditation;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod recognizes the important role of Civil Society Organizations as the city's strong partners in the realization of its developmental goals;

WHEREAS, various Civil Society Organizations have submitted their respective letters of application for accreditation to the Sangguniang Panlungsod together with all the above-mentioned documentary requirements.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Coun. Arlene Jane Alvarez-Reyes, duly seconded, be it-

RESOLVED, as it hereby resolved, to accredit the following Civil Society Organizations as strong partners in the realization of the developmental goals of the City Government of Santiago, to wit:


1. Santiago City Isabela Night Trikers Association, Inc.; and
2. National Auxiliary Chaplaincy Philippines, Inc. (NACPHIL), Santiago City Chapter

RESOLVED FURTHER, that these accreditations shall cover the time from the date of this approval up to June 30, 2016 to coincide with the new set of Local Development Council of Santiago City for the term July 01, 2013 to June 30, 2016.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution to all persons, offices, and government agencies concerned for their information and guidance.


