**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND  
DEVELOPMENT REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE, THROUGH REGIONAL  
DIRECTOR REMIA T. TAPISPISAN, FOR RESOURCE ALLOCATION  
OF THE CORE SHELTER ASSISTANCE PROJECT (CSAP) IN THE  
AMOUNT OF TWENTY EIGHT MILLION PESOS (P28,000,000.00)  
TO CONSTRUCT FOUR HUNDRED (400) HOUSING  
UNITS IN SANTIAGO CITY**



**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Santiago desires to avail of four hundred (400) housing units out of the Core Shelter Assistance Project (CSAP) and the DSWD's Resolution No. 10-11-12 for those families whose houses were damaged and flooded by previous typhoons and informal settlers whose house are made of light materials and are situated in hazardous/danger areas within the locality;

**WHEREAS**, Santiago City has a resettlement and housing project site situated in Barangay Bannawag Norte wherein the requested 400 CSAP housing units maybe constructed;

**WHEREAS**, Santiago City appreciates the quick response of the DSWD on projects that support the welfare of its constituents that were rendered homeless due to calamities;

**WHEREFORE**, on motion of Coun. Arlene Jane Alvarez-Reyes, duly seconded, be it -

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to earnestly request the Department of Social Welfare & Development Regional Field Office, through Regional Director Remia T. Tapisipan, for resource allocation of the Core Shelter Assistance Project (CSAP) in the amount of Twenty Eight Million Pesos (P28,000,000.00) to construct four hundred (400) housing units in Santiago City.


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to express the willingness of the City Government of Santiago to provide its counterpart for the project.



**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to forward copies of this resolution to the DSWD-RFO II, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan, through Regional Director Remia T.
